TRIAD HEALTH PROJECT

Founded in 1986, Triad Health Project (THP) is a community based, non-profit organization that provides practical support to people infected with or affected by HIV/AIDS.

With programs ranging from individual case management to HIV/AIDS education and prevention, our approach is both comprehensive and inclusive. Our professional staff and volunteers understand the unique needs of people infected with and affected by HIV/AIDS. They are dedicated to providing support in an environment of compassion, hope and understanding.



DIRECT CLIENT SERVICES

Professional case management empowers HIV-infected individuals to stabilize and improve the quality of their lives. THP clients include people from different racial, social and economic backgrounds who have an array of needs: medical care, access to HIV medications, support groups, housing, crisis intervention, mental health, and substance abuse counseling. THP also provides limited client transportation and food distribution.

HIGHER GROUND

Established in 2000, Higher Ground exists to provide an open-door community for HIV-positive persons, their spouses and others interested in fighting HIV/AIDS. The house is a space for people to come together for concrete programs which assist the marginalized and underserved to maintain their health and re-enter society, and to educate the community about the efforts of HIV and its treatment. These programs include meals, support groups, alternative and holistic therapy sessions and community activities, as well as special presentations by area health-care providers and providers of other services that are trying to reach out to HIV positive individuals in our community.

EDUCATION/PREVENTION

Our education and prevention staff provides *free*, on-site confidential HIV testing and counseling. They also offer targeted outreach for at-risk populations that include alternative testing sites, condom distribution, and information booths and staffing for special events. *Prevention for Positives* programs include specialized trainings to help participants cope with the disease and prevent future infections. Prevention and education speakers are also available for local groups and organizations.
