TRIAD HEALTH PROJECT:



Founded in 1986, Triad Health Project (THP) is a community based non-profit organization that provides practical and emotional support to people infected with or affected by HIV/AIDS.

DIRECT CLIENT SERVICES:

Professional Case Management empowers HIV+ individuals to stabilize and improve their health and the quality of their lives. The focus of Case Management services is to help clients make connections to resources and support. THP clients include people from many racial, ethnic, social, and economic backgrounds who have an array of needs:

- Medical care
- Access to HIV medications
- Support groups
- Housing
- Crisis intervention
- Mental health and substance abuse treatment
- Nutritional services

HIGHER GROUND:

Higher Ground is a day program operated by THP and is open Monday- Friday. Established in 1995, Higher Ground offers an



open and affirming space of community for HIV+ persons, their loved ones, and others coping with HIV/AIDS. Higher Ground offers nutritious, family-style lunches three days a week, along with:

- Support groups
- Retreat programs
- Counseling
- Recreational activities
- Traditional and holistic therapies
- Artistic, spiritual, and therapeutic workshops

PREVENTION:

Our education and prevention staff provides free and confidential testing and counseling onsite for:

- HIV/AIDS
- Syphilis
- Gonorrhea
- Chlamydia

We also offer targeted outreach for at-risk populations that include:

- Community testing sites
- Free condom distribution
- HIV/STI 101 presentations
- Men's and women's groups
- Health fairs

FOOD PANTRY:

THP houses a food pantry, where clients can receive a weekly bag of groceries which would not be possible without community support and donations. We are always in need of:
